



Tacade is a leading not-for-profit charitable organisation working in the field of personal, social, health and citizenship education (including drug, alcohol, tobacco and sexual health issues) for children and young people. Increasingly, Tacade works with the more vulnerable, at risk, young people.

Tacade's Aims. 'To make an effective contribution to improving the health of children and young people by enabling those with responsibility and influence to encourage positive changes in knowledge, attitudes, skills and behaviours.'

Over 75% of primary schools and more than 50% of secondary schools in the UK use Tacade's materials.

Tacade has worked across the world helping countries such as Uganda, Italy, Belize, Georgia, Mexico, Hong Kong and Australia to produce culturally sensitive and appropriate Life Skills materials

Tacade has successfully developed and managed local, national and European projects including 'Away from Home' with University Students in Germany, Greece, Spain and the United Kingdom; and 'Sexual Health Service for Young People'; for the Salford and Trafford Primary Care Trust.

Tacade delivers targeted training courses in the United Kingdom on all aspects of personal, social, health and citizenship education. Issues covered include drugs, alcohol, tobacco and sexual health and relationships.

Internationally, Tacade has worked with the European Commission, the World Health Organisation and UNICEF as a consultant in countries including Belize, Bolivia, Dubai, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovenia and Uganda.

Tacade also assists companies with the development of workplace drug and alcohol policies.

In 1985, Lions Clubs International, MD105, signed a partnership agreement with Tacade. The aims of this agreement were for Tacade to produce materials and LCI MD105 to assist in the funding and distribution of these materials. A joint committee of Lions and members of the Tacade staff meet regularly to discuss issues of mutual interest and concern. Objectives and future targets are negotiated and agreed, with both parties working together to achieve those objectives.
